High Desert Vex Robotics League for the 2011-12 school year.

In association with VEX Robotics Sultana High School has been given the opportunity to create a VEX Robotics League. League play is a new concept to the VEX competition play. The league play concept is going to allow areas with a high concentrations of VEX teams to easily manage the growing number of robotic teams and allowing all levels of teams a chance to participate. The High Desert League will have up to 40 teams competing in six tournaments and taking the top scores from five of those six tournaments.

League Guidelines

The league qualifying sessions structures are structured to allow teams to play 4 of 6 league matches. Teams will earn points by winning matches and the

calculation of each teams WPs and SPs points. (*Win Points and Strength of Schedule points*) This gives teams the flexibility to schedule around potential conflicts and allow for more qualifying matches.

League Finals

League play finals will only be 2 team alliances, not the traditional three. Alliance selection will be done based off the final league standings, where teams will have their best 4 match score calculated. Teams failing to compete 4 league matches will have not have the opportunity to discard any scores.
